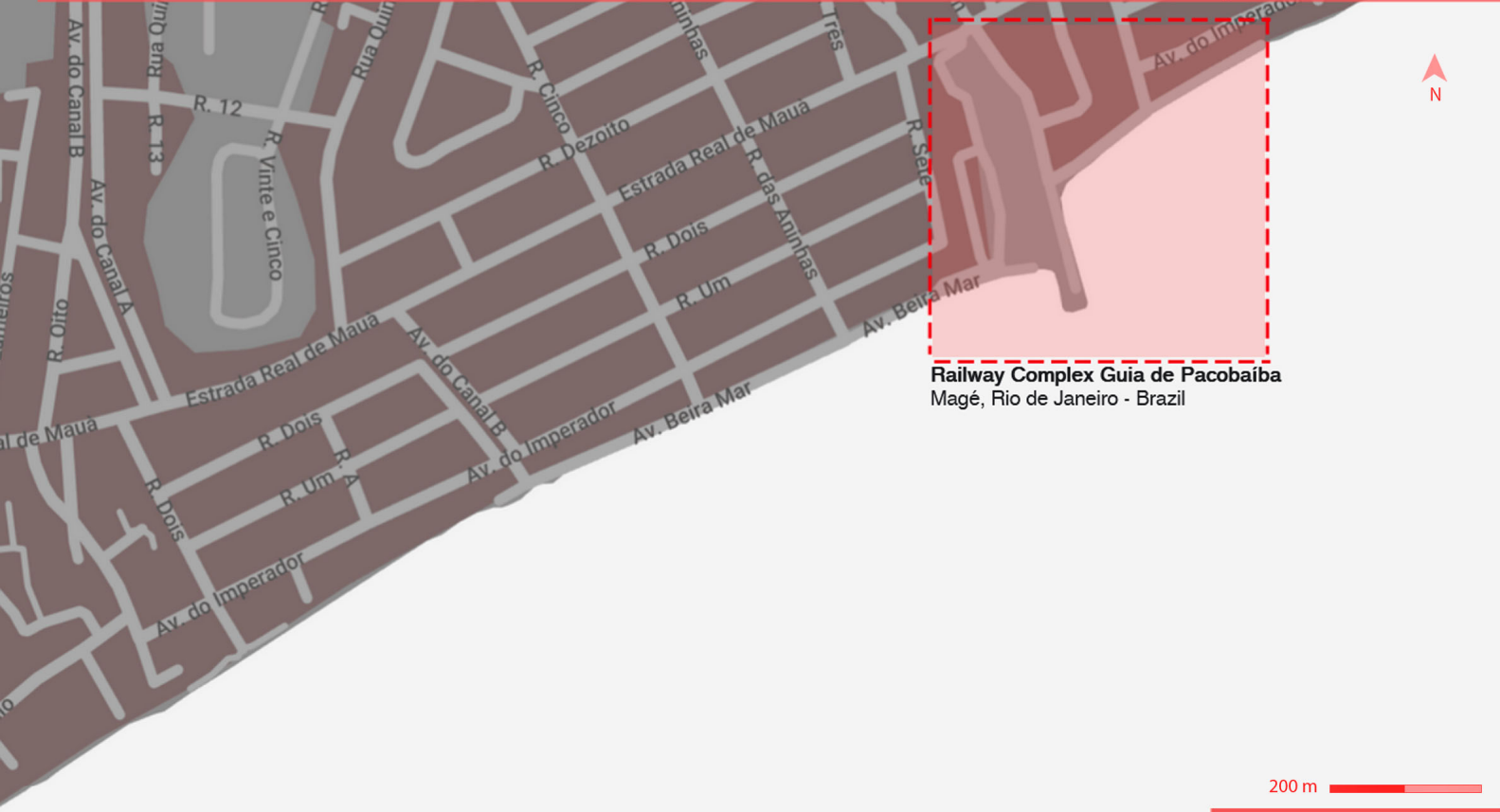


HERITAGE EDUCATION PROJECT - HERITAGE IS FOR ALL

The "Heritage is for All" education project was recently implemented in Guia de Pacobaíba, Magé, Brazil. This project is a public policy initiative proposed and developed by the Department of Culture of the city of Magé in 2021. Its main objective is to offer an **immersive experience** to students from public schools, allowing them to explore and appreciate the most important heritage and landmarks of Magé. Through this experience, students are introduced to the diverse cultural and identity manifestations of this space, and learn about its **sociocultural significance** in the formation of the city. The project seeks to showcase the variety of heritage sites present in the territory and highlight their importance, promoting a deeper appreciation for the city's cultural heritage.

The first heritage to be addressed by the project was **Guia de Pacobaíba Railway Complex**, the first railway in Brazil, also considered national heritage by IPHAN (National Institute for Historic and Artistic Heritage)
